

Students are invited to step up to the One World Challenge, and create a solution to address a current environmental or conservation issue. This program is open to all students Pre-K through 12th grade that attend a school with a Local PTA/PTSA that is in good standing with Texas PTA. A solution may be developed at home or at school. Each year, Texas PTA highlights a current environmental or conservation issue for students to utilize in creating their solution. The One World Challenge allows for students to be recognized at the Local PTA/PTSA and State PTA levels. State-level judging will occur in April, with program results published prior to the end of the school year.

Students may enter the One World Challenge in the appropriate division for their grade. **The entry deadline is MARCH 11, 2013**, in the front office. The divisions are as follows:

Pre-K - 2nd Grade
3rd Grade - 5th Grade
6th Grade - 8th Grade
9th Grade - 12th Grade

Texas PTA does not limit the number of solutions a student may enter in the One World Challenge. Solutions may be submitted in any of the following three formats:

Visual - Open to all grade divisions
Essay - Open to Intermediate, Middle/Junior and Senior grade divisions
Public Service Announcement - Open to Intermediate, Middle/Junior and Senior grade divisions

Originality

Each solution must be original and the work of one student, with the exception of the group public service announcement. An adult may not alter the integrity of a student's solution.

Use of copyrighted material (other than recorded music used during PSA entries) is prohibited.

Plagiarism is defined as taking and using another person's ideas, writings, or inventions as one's own. Any research used within a solution must be identified and credited to the proper source. Plagiarized entries will be disqualified.
